



Dr Mark Velangi is Consultant Haematologist in Birmingham Children's Hospital and regional lead for the paediatric haemoglobinopathy service. He graduated from the University of Edinburgh Medical School in 1991. In 2006 he joined the team at Birmingham Children's Hospital which has a large sickle cell and thalassaemia unit.
